

Why We Need To Modernize Our Fire Station

- 1. Existing firehouse is inadequate for the needs of the community and the volunteer force.
- 2. Full compliance with state mandates and industry standards is not possible in the existing spaces.
- 3. Current industry standard engines, ladder trucks, and tankers will not fit in the existing bays as the older pieces of apparatus age out of service, which is imminent.
- 4. Inadequate clearances around large apparatus; a safety issue for the volunteers. Inadequate storage for expensive and vital equipment.
- 5. The World Health Organization has recently classified fire-fighting as a carcinogenic activity. Existing firehouse does not provide a healthy, safe, or practical workspace for the Chappaqua volunteer firefighters.
- 6. No facilities for firefighters to change/shower/decontaminate after fire calls.
- 7. No clean zones for firefighters' gear which is a huge health issue for the volunteers.

- **8**.All of these health concerns make it more difficult to recruit volunteers.
- 9.Plan we will submit to the public has been well-thought out over 20 years.
- **10**. Plans were made in consultation with experts across the various fields including Architecture, Engineering, Construction, Traffic, Environmental Protection and NYS Fire Safety compliance.
